Each treat station must hand out a MINIMUM of 4-5 pieces of individually wrapped candy to each trick-or-treater.

Decorations

Choose a theme and we encourage you to incorporate your banner and business name into your decorations.

Items not allowed for decorating include, but are not limited to, confetti, wire and tinsel decorations, and balloons. Call with any questions. **Soliciting information from guests and campaigning is not permitted.**

YOUR TIME

Meeting

A pre-event meeting with each business will be scheduled to go over rules, logistics and allow you to pick your treat trail location.

Day Before Event

All stations must be set up the Friday before the event.

Day of Event

Please be set up and be ready to go by 9:30 AM. **Minimum (2) adult workers must be present at your station until 4 PM.** You cannot shut down your station and leave early. The last guests deserve the same experience as the first.

YOUR WORKERS

Attire

Wear costumes to carry out your chosen theme or business uniform shirts can be worn. No civilian clothes please.

Restrictions

Workers should be at least 13 years of age. Volunteer workers should stay at your station during their shift and not wander through the Zoo. Young children should not be brought to Zoo Boo while you are working. Workers are required to follow all Zoo policies and rules.

Family members and friends of workers are not permitted to enter with your workers.

WE PROVIDE

Food & Drinks

Drinks and snacks will be available for sponsors and their workers at Volunteer Central. Snacks, including lunch and supper, will be served in Education Building B. (Coolers with water and non-alcoholic beverages are permitted at your station.)

Tables & Chairs

The Zoo will provide tables and chairs for your station. We don't provide tents.
